Discussion Questions

1. Who is your favorite fairy tale princess and why?
2. How do you feel about the Universal Call to Holiness? Do you believe God made you to be immaculate? How well are you answering this call in your life right now? How can having a relationship with Mary help you?
3. Are you head-over-heels in love with Jesus? Just holding hands? Not sure about him yet? The Rosary is the primary means by which Mary, Mediatrix of All Grace, introduces us to Jesus and helps us open up to receive his love. How do you feel about the Rosary? If you don't pray the Rosary regularly, what challenges prevent you from doing so? If you do pray it often, how did you grow to love it?

To Pray About On Your Own

Mary is the only woman in human history who was truly free at every moment of her earthly existence. Another way to say this is that she was Pure of Heart, desiring all that is right and good without need for external laws to tell her how to live. How free are you? What commandments or Church teachings do you still need to remind you what is right and good? Are you ready to open up your disordered desires to the Lord so He can redeem them for you? (Ex. If you are comfortable missing Mass on Sunday once in a while, then you are not free from the 3rd Commandment – Keep Holy The Sabbath)
